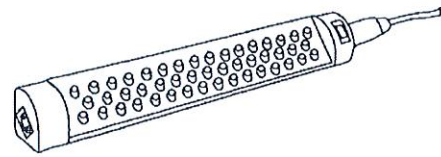

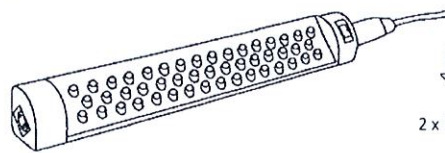

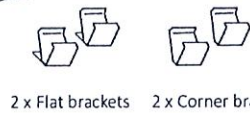

1 x Albus LED Strip Light with connecting cable, 1m mains cable



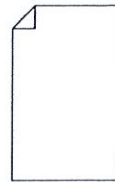
2 x Flat brackets 2 x Corner brackets

2 x Screws



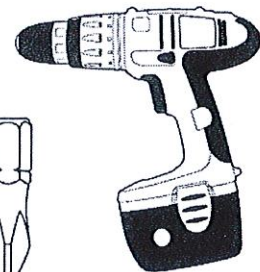

**Important safety information**

Please read these instructions carefully before attempting to install this product. It is advisable to keep these instructions in a safe place for further reference.

**We recommend that you consult a qualified electrician. All electrical installations must be carried out in accordance with current IEE wiring regulations (BS7671).**

These products must not be modified, if any modifications are made, it may invalidate the warranty and may render the product unsafe.

**Do not wire the individual LED light fittings directly to the mains. This product is for indoor use only. Keep out of moisture and use only in dry rooms.**

- If in doubt installation must be carried out by a qualified electrician.
- Make sure that cable connectors are connected to the suitable end of the fitting.
- Be careful not to damage the PCB board when installing the fixing screws.
- Install on smooth flat surface(s) only.
- This product operates at 240V.

**Safety instructions**

1. Before commencing installation or maintenance, isolate the main electrical supply for the appropriate circuit at the fuse board.
2. The light should be mounted onto a secure surface.
3. Position lights where they will not be exposed to steam or splashes etc.
4. The lamp must not be covered by loft insulation.
5. Suitable for furniture lighting.
6. When the lamp expires the fitting must be replaced.
7. Class II appliance rating.
8. Only use with approved accessories.

**Waste Electrical & Electronic Equipment (WEEE)**
